

The **Transition Town Reading** initiative is a community-led response to the pressures of climate change, fossil fuel depletion and increasingly, economic contraction. There are thousands of initiatives around the world starting their journey to answer this crucial question:

*"How can we make our community stronger and happier as we deal with the impacts of peak oil and economic contraction while at the same time urgently reducing CO<sub>2</sub> emissions?"*

So, how do we go about it?

- ✿ Raise awareness around peak oil, climate change and the need to undertake a community-led process to rebuild resilience and reduce carbon.
- ✿ Connect with existing groups, including local government, in the community.
- ✿ Form groups to look at all the key areas of life (food, energy, transport, health, heart & soul, economics & livelihoods, etc).
- ✿ Kick off practical projects aimed at building people's understanding of resilience and carbon issues and community engagement.
- ✿ Engage in a community-wide visioning process to identify the future we want for ourselves rather than waiting for someone else to create a future that we won't like.
- ✿ Eventually launch a community defined, community implemented "Energy Descent Action Plan" over a 15 to 20 year timescale.
